Learn Local courses

Learn Local courses are short courses at low or no cost to eligible adult Victorians.

This course guide has information about a wide range of courses available in 2023 in your area, including:

- · Digital literacy training
- Language, literacy and numeracy skills
- English language classes
- · Financial literacy skills
- Employability skills
- · Occupational Health and Safety
- Industry specific training across a wide range of sectors (including health, disability, retail, tourism, hospitality, construction, trades, business, call centres, horticulture plus many more)

These courses can help you at any stage of your learning and can be a pathway to work.

Learn Local courses are flexible and can be tailored to suit your needs. You can learn at the pace that you choose in a classroom, online or hybrid. Class sizes are often small. Training is delivered by experienced professionals in a relaxed environment.

The Learn Local courses in this guide are a sample of the range of courses on offer. New courses are continually being developed and offered across Victoria. Details about new courses can be found at www.learnlocal.org.au

Courses are usually between 20 and 60 hours. Many Learn Local providers also offer shorter courses, designed to re-engage learners.

Learn Local locations

Around 240 not-for-profit community organisations across Victoria that offer Learn Local courses. These organisations are known as Learn Local providers. They are registered and funded by the Victorian Government, via the Adult, Community and Further Education Board.

Learn Local providers

Learn Local providers are friendly and welcoming, with highly capable and professional trainers. They are focused on helping you to achieve your goals. Learn Local providers know their local communities well and they can help you:

- Undertake a pre-employment course to help you find a job
- Improve your digital literacy and computer skills

- Improve your reading, writing and maths skills
- Access English language classes > Improve your financial literacy skills
- Go on to further study or gain a qualification at a TAFE or other training provider
- Build your confidence and learn something new.
